Our shares contain 7-10 different kinds of vegetables each week. The amount of each item depends on the season, the weather, and other forces beyond our control. Please refer to the Second Wind blog for archived lists of the contents of shares for the 2011 season.

Member agreement

When purchasing a share, you agree to the following:

Your payment entitles you to a weekly share of produce.

You will share in the risks and rewards of the seasons with the farmers and other shareholders.

Due to weather and other variables, you may receive more or less produce that you expect.

It is your responsibility to pick up your share during the scheduled distribution; if you fail to do so, it will be discarded.
